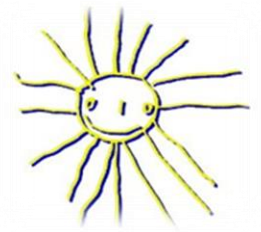


# Netherton Moss Primary School
