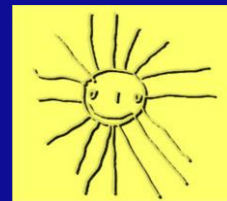

Those children who have moved up to year 3 who are not entitled to free school meals, must now pay for their school meals. The cost for junior children, years 3 to 6 is £2.53p per day or £12.65p per week. The cost for nursery children is £2.23p per day.
